
GREECE

All-Time Classic

The myths, culture, and art of this 6,000-island-and-islet country raise expectations to heights as seemingly infinite as the Aegean and Ionian Seas are deep. And yet, this destination manages to surpass the most vivid dreams.

Under the hot Mediterranean sun, every one of the 227 inhabited islands has its own story to tell. In the main archipelago, Athens thrives, adapting fluidly to the times while paying homage to its history, carefully preserving its heritage. The whitewashed buildings stacked sky-high, blue roofs that match the cobalt seas, and straw-thatched windmills are iconic of the islands of Mykonos and Santorini.

On Crete, its location as the southernmost outpost of Greece lends itself to the mythology that remains an ongoing source of study. Influenced by the Venetians, French, and British, cosmopolitan Corfu proves just as fascinating with its UNESCO-listed Old Town and shores that are designed for pure holiday pleasure.





GREECE 7-DAY CURATED ITINERARY

Day 1 – Arrival in Athens

After settling in, explore the Old Town of Plaka. Browse its tiny boutiques, sidewalk cafés, and family-run taverns, then continue on to nearby Anafiotika, where you'll discover whitewashed homes and an island vibe. After, admire the illuminated Acropolis before sitting down to a traditional Greek dinner.

Day 2 – Athens

Today, visit the famous Acropolis. Explore the Parthenon, Temple of Athena Nike, Erechtheion, and Propylaia, learning about each structure's unique history. End at the Acropolis Museum, discovering Classical Greek works of art returned home. Enjoy the rest of the day at leisure, perhaps continuing your tour through history at the Ancient Agora or diving into modern Athenian culture in Monastiraki Square.

Day 3 – Day Trip to Delphi

In the 6th century BCE, Delphi was the religious center and symbol of unity of the Greek world. Learn about its historical significance on a *Full-Day Delphi Tour with Lunch*. Visit the ruins of the Sanctuary of Apollo, the Treasury of the Athenians, the Temple of Apollo, and the Temple of Apollo and its museum, where you can view ancient Greek sculptures and works of art.

Day 4 – Mykonos

Board a 50-minute flight to the island of Mykonos, known for its Cycladic architecture. Most of the town is closed to cars so you can freely walk its winding cobbled alleys and take in its abundance of restaurants, bars, cafés, art galleries, and high-end shops. See the oft-photographed whitewashed houses, characteristic windmills, and iconic beaches. Finish the day in Little Venice, a series of seaside alleys with bustling nightlife and spectacular sunset views.

Day 5 – Mykonos

Today, experience the best of Mykonos on Viator's *Authentic Mykonos* tour. This full-day private guided tour stops at Mykonos Town, Agios Ioannis Beach, the island of Delos, the Lighthouse of Armenistis (*Faros Armenistis*), the charming Ano Mera, the historic monastery of Panagia Tourliani on the main square, and some of the best beaches of this stunning island.

Day 6 – Day Trip to Delos

As the mythological birthplace of Apollo, the archeological site of Delos is one of the most significant ancient landmarks in the Aegean Sea. Reserve Viator's *Ancient Delos* tour to learn about the island's history and myths while visiting legendary landmarks such as the Agora, the Sacred Way, and the Temple of Apollo.

Day 7 – Departure from Mykonos

Before bidding farewell to Greece, return to the shore for one last beach day. Ornos Beach on the southern coast and Perivola Beach on the northeastern side are perfect for swimming while, on the western end, Panormos Beach is arguably Mykonos' most popular beach.








ATHENS

As thriving of a metropolis as ever, visitors say that the golden age of Athens is not yet over. This capital of Greece and unofficial historical capital of Europe is a destination with neighborhoods of unhurried stillness and exciting whirlwinds.

Psiri is a designated nightlife neighborhood, where boutiques call by day and ouzeries bustle by night. Wealthy Kolonaki Square's high-end shopping delights, and the Thission neighborhood—between Phillipapou Hill and the world-famous Acropolis—features tavernas, more cafés, and restaurants.

Not to be forgotten is the shopping avenue of Ermou Street, part of the largest pedestrian zone in all of Europe. Here, sunny days can be lost among international brands and authentic Greek goods, making for a wonderful place for visitors to begin their journeys into the past. Archeological sites across Athens number over 100, with the most emblematic being the Acropolis.

No less impressive is the Panathenaic Olympic Stadium, originally constructed in 330 BCE and rebuilt for the first modern Olympic Games—a monumental testament to the longstanding architectural traditions of Greece.

ATHENS TOURS

Delphi Full-Day Tour

Drive through the plain of Beotia, crossing the towns of Thebes, Levadia, and Arachova to arrive at Delphi, the “Navel of Earth.” On the slopes of Mt. Parnassus, see the ruins of the Sanctuary of Apollo, famous site of oracles. Visit the Treasury of the Athenians, Temple of Apollo, and its museum’s ancient masterpieces. Lunch in the modern village of Delphi and return to Athens by the same route at 7:30 PM.

Half-Day Cape Sounion

Take a coastal drive past the beaches of Glyfada, Vouliagmeni, and Varkiza—the Athenian Riviera—for views of the Saronic Gulf and its offshore islands to the southernmost point of Attica, Cape Sounion, and the Temple of Poseidon. After visiting the temple, walk at leisure on the rocky promontory to take it all in.

City Highlights & Cape Sounion

Do it all with this ambitious itinerary. See the Panathenaic Olympics Stadium, Hadrian’s Arch, the Parthenon, public squares, the Acropolis and its new museum, historic temples, and academic and government buildings all before a local lunch. Stunning beaches and views of the Saronic Gulf from the southernmost point of Attica, Cape Sounion, and the Temple of Poseidon follow.

Night Out in Athens

Your evening begins with a short panoramic drive through the city center and the slopes of the sacred hill to admire and take photos of the illuminated Acropolis. A pleasant walk through the narrow picturesque streets of Plaka, the old city, will bring you to a typical Greek tavern to enjoy dinner and a floor show with live music and Greek folk dances in traditional garb.

Half-Day Athens, Acropolis & Museum

See the Athens essentials, then the architectural masterpieces of the Golden Age of Athens at the Acropolis, including the Temple of Athena Nike and the Parthenon. Return to Athens for the place where ancient statues found their home: the New Acropolis Museum, voted by *The Sunday Times* as the third best museum of the world.

Day Cruise to Aegina, Poros and Hydra

Disembark first in Hydra, a favorite for its traditional stone houses and turbulent history. Take two hours to traverse by foot or on a saddled donkey and make your way to the seaside promenade and shops before heading to small Poros and large Aegina. There, you can buy tickets for an add-on tour of the Temple of Afea archeological site.

Argolis Full-Day Tour

Drive along the Saronic Gulf, stopping by Corinth Canal, to Mycenae, the Homeric city “rich in gold.” Visit the Lion’s Gate, Cyclopean Walls, and Royal Tombs before breaking for lunch. Depart for Nafplio through the plain of Argolis. Snap shots of the cliff-top Palamidi Fortress before leaving for Epidaurus’s 4th century BCE theater famous for its acoustics. Return to Athens by coastal road around 7:30 PM.

Corinth, Mycenae & Nafplio Private

Explore the remains of two of the country’s most important archaeological sites, Ancient Corinth and Mycenae, along with picturesque Nafplio, the capital during Ottoman rule. See the impressive Corinth Canal, Corinth’s agora and museum, the Ached Tombs of the Kings and the Lion’s Gate in Mycenae. **V**







Leave Heraklion by luxury chauffeured vehicle for a beach paradise sculpted by nature during ancient times that is someday connected to the coastline of southwest Crete, and on others, an island you can easily wade to through a shallow sea corridor. Bask in the intermingled Cretan and Libyan Seas in a group of just your companion(s) and guide.

Wine & Olive Oil Tour

Experience Crete above and under the Aegean Sea with this three-hour guided snorkeling or stand-up paddleboarding trip from Chania. Swim in the crystal blue waters in Almyrida Chania, explore reefs and caves, and see the Elephant Cave of Crete. All equipment is provided on the boat.

WWII – The Battle of Crete

Seeing the locations of this important battle without a guide could leave you with only a patchy take on this pivotal event. With this tour from Chania, learn about the events of the Nazi seizure in 1941 at key sites; visit the Maleme airfield, monuments, and cemeteries; and discover secret shelters and sites you might otherwise miss.






CORFU

In the continued path of the knights, wander the Acropolis of Lindos, which they restored and the Ministry of Culture now protects. A climb up a hill near ancient lalysos rewards you with the peace of a monastery—that of Filerimos, to be precise—while one on Monte Smith takes you to another acropolis, this not yet fully excavated but already named after the island itself.

But most importantly, the roads of Rhodes lead to a dive into the past that you'll remember far into the future.
