## THINGS TO KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

To ensure you're fully prepared for your European vacation, please refer to the information below and consult your travel advisor with any questions.

### NEW ETA REQUIREMENT

An Electronic Travel Authorization (ETA) [entry permit](#) will soon be required for American travelers visiting the United Kingdom, including Northern Ireland. This requirement is expected to become effective in 2025. Refer to the [ETA website](#) for updates.

### DOCUMENTATION

Proper documentation is your responsibility. For travel to European countries, your passport must be valid for up to **6 months** after your return. Contact your advisor or the consulates of the countries you're visiting for the most current requirements. We strongly recommend carrying a color copy of your passport's picture page on your person; however, if traveling between countries, carry your actual passport. If you've been immunized for COVID-19, we suggest bringing your vaccine card.

### HEALTH & SAFETY

We strongly recommend that you visit the [U.S. Department of State](#) and [Center for Disease Control and Prevention](#) websites for important information on foreign travel, as well as our Health & Safety Tips.

### BAGGAGE

The standard carry-on size for European carriers is slightly smaller than U.S. domestic flights, measuring 21.7 by 15.7 by 9 inches. Please check your [air carrier's website](#) to ensure that your baggage size and weight meet their requirements.

### ELECTRONICS

The official voltage for Europe, the UK, and Ireland is 230, whereas most U.S. outlets are 110V. If your appliances don't use this voltage, you'll need to purchase an outlet converter adaptable for 2 round-pronged or 3 flat rectangle-pronged (UK and Ireland) outlets.

### ACCOMMODATIONS AND MEAL PLANS

In general, rooms are smaller than in the Americas, and washcloths and toiletries are often not provided. Many hotels offer meal plans such as:

**All-inclusive** – Includes all meals, select drinks, daily activities, and nightly entertainment. Such plans may also be referred to as *Endless Privileges*® or *Unlimited-Luxury*®.

**Full-board** – Includes breakfast, lunch, and dinner.

**Half-board** – Includes breakfast and lunch.

### DINING OUT

Tipping in restaurants is appreciated, but often not expected. When tipping is common, 5% is normal and 10% is considered generous. Service is generally less hurried than in the Americas.



## FINAL WORDS OF WISDOM

Travel light, wear comfortable shoes, and ensure your luggage has sturdy wheels to withstand the steps and cobbled streets of Europe. Finally, be prepared to pay a small fee for the use of public restrooms!

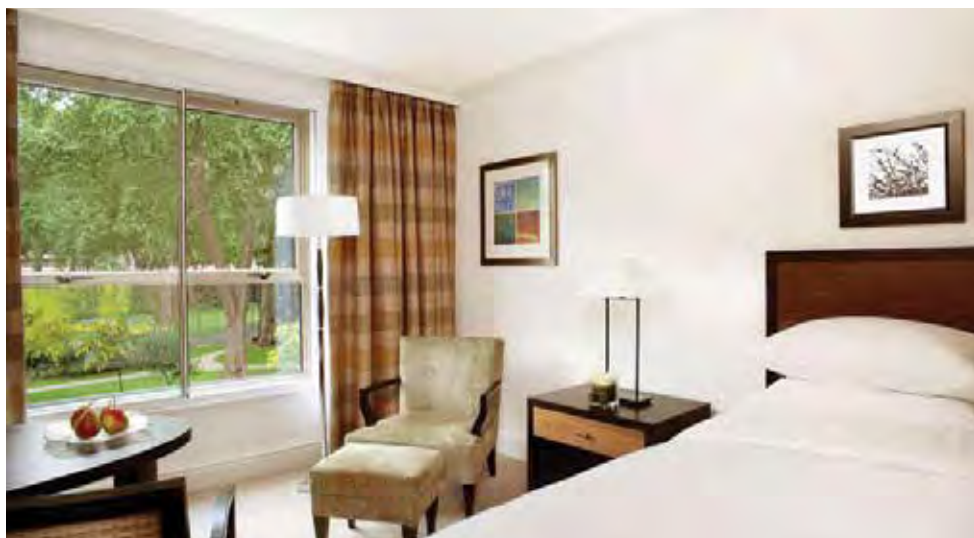

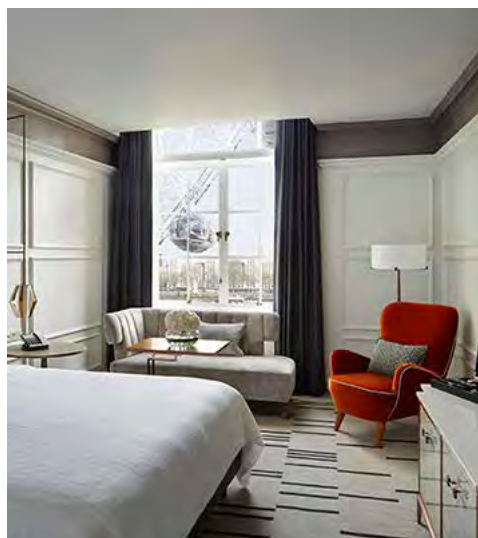

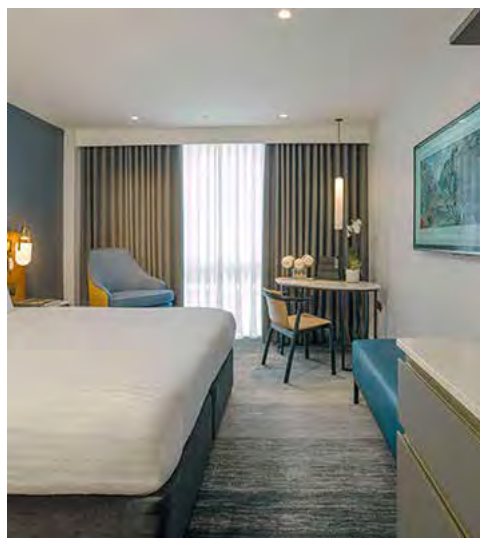

Go on to the Victoria Baths in Chorlton-on-Medlock, a Mancunian treasure featured on the BBC; the Lowry in Salford Quays for performing arts; The Royal Exchange Theatre for Shakespearean works staged by an award-winning troupe; or by taking the youngsters out for the Manchester Museum’s Big Saturday’s educational activities. Shopping on Market Street in the Manchester Amdale, Trafford Centre, high-end King Street, and The Avenue at Spinningfields provide additional recreation, and neighborhoods like the collegiate Oxford Road, swanky Deansgate, boho North Quarter, and Canal Street keep celebrations going all night and into distant memory.



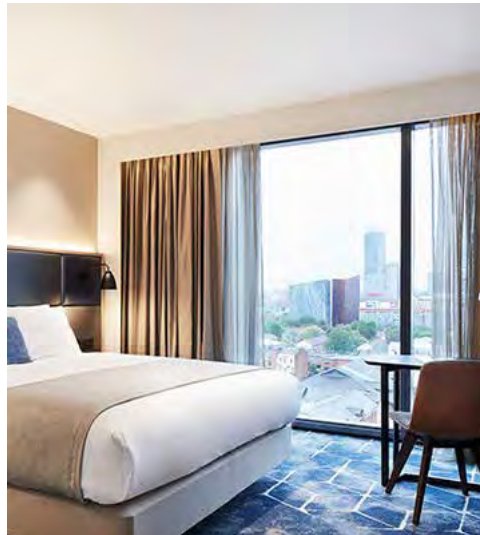

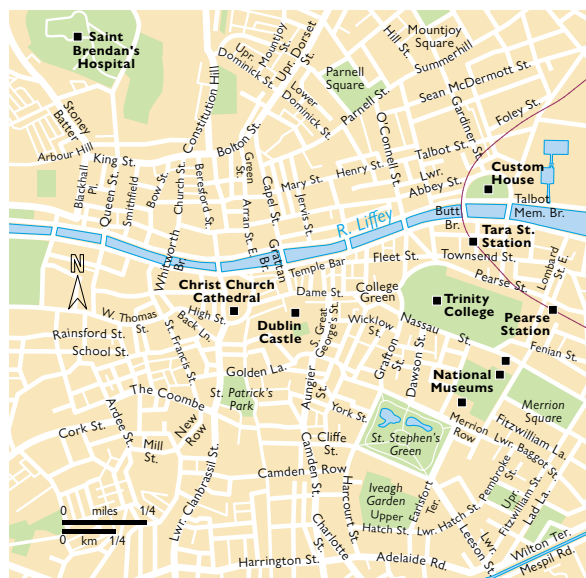


# DUBLIN
